

Section 1: Information

CAMPER FORMS

Camper forms must be filled out online, printed, signed and brought to camp. Camper forms will be available May 15 and must be completed 2 weeks prior to your camp session. Cabin mates and baptism permission can be verified or completed during this process. See Section 2.

PAYMENTS

- Mandatory, non-refundable half payment due April 1. Full payment and Trading Post funds may also be made at this time.
- ALL payments – Full Tuition and Trading Post Funds – must be paid no later than 2 weeks before the session starts, but can be paid at anytime prior to the 2 week deadline.

CAMPERS SHOULD ATTEND THE ENTIRE SESSION

It is disruptive to cabin unity and the camping experience to come late or leave early. Notify us prior to your session if there are extenuating circumstances.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

If unable to attend, notify camp immediately so the next person on the waitlist can be contacted. Half payment is nonrefundable and no refunds will be given for cancellations made within 10 days prior to the camp session.

ARRIVAL AT CAMP

Registration opens at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday of your camp session. Do not arrive before 8:00 a.m. as our staff will not be ready to greet you. Registration ends at 3:00 p.m. Bring the requested documents.

ARRIVAL DAY, WORSHIP, LUNCH

Registration will close temporarily for worship at 10:00. Everyone is invited to join our worship. Lunch will be served about 12:30 in the Dining Hall. Visitors are welcome to join us for lunch at \$5 a plate. Lunch is free for campers and staff.

DEPARTURE FROM CAMP

Campers must be picked up from camp no later than 9:00 a.m. on the final day of the session; which is Saturday of one week sessions and Friday of two-week sessions.

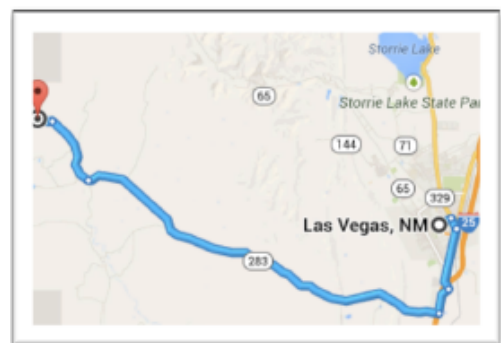
COMMUNICATION AND LETTERS

Contact the office at info@campbluehaven.com or call Camp Blue Haven at 505-454-0100. Campers are not allowed to call home except for emergencies or to receive baptism permission. DIRECTIONS TO CAMP

Use the access road on the east side of I-25 between Las Vegas and Romeroville. The second overpass north of Romeroville (first overpass south of Las Vegas) is marked by signs to Camp Blue Haven. Go west on Hwy 283 about 15 miles, following the signs to camp. View on Google Map.



DRESS CODE

T-shirts and jeans are best for daily wear. Casual dress (skirts/slacks) is appropriate for Sunday morning and banquet. Theme-related costumes may be preferred for the banquet. Modesty and camp dress code must be observed at all times. Campers will be asked to change anything deemed inappropriate. The dress code does NOT allow shorts, tank-tops, tight or low-cut tops, sagging pants, shirts that show the midriff, skirts/dresses above the knee, sandals (a safety issue), or any clothing displaying un-Christ-like designs, slogans, or images.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Tobacco (in any form), illegal drugs, alcohol, lighters, firearms, fireworks, knives/pocket knives, or electric guitars are not allowed. In order to “unplug” and focus on Christ, all electronics – music, gaming, video, and phones – are forbidden. CELL PHONES ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED and will be locked up for the session.

MEDICAL STAFF

A medical professional (LVN, RN, MD, or Paramedic) is on duty 24 hours a day.

LUNCHTIME ATTIRE

Each day during lunch, campers and staff are encouraged to dress up! See the special days sheet included in this packet. Please bring costumes to join the fun!

SPENDING MONEY

All money is deposited in the camper’s Trading Post account. The account is debited as purchases are made. Remaining balances are returned to the camper at the end of each session. We recommend \$50 for a 1-week session and \$75 for a 2-week session. CBH is not responsible for money not deposited at the Trading Post.

DAILY RECREATION

Every camper will attend Bible classes, chapel, worship services, and devotionals. Optional recreation will include fishing, sports and games, nature hike, arts and crafts, air riflery and archery. Campers will participate in half-day hikes. Two-week campers will also participate on an all-day hike. All activities are supervised.

CHALLENGE COURSE

We have a full challenge course facility, including a zip line and a giant swing, supervised by trained and licensed staff. Each Bible class uses low ropes elements to focus on spiritual applications.

LAUNDRY

Two-week campers have a portion of their clothes washed for them mid-session at no cost. One-week campers are not able to do laundry.

CAMPER FORMS

Fill out. Print. Sign. Bring.

CBH has an ON-LINE process for camper forms.

1. Go to - <http://signup.campbluehaven.com/camperform>
2. Find your camper - name, city, and email must be exactly as used to register
3. Fill out each form ON-LINE
 - Form A - Camper Information
 - Form B - Medication Administration Record
 - Form C - Parent Authorization
4. **PRINT** all three forms
5. **SIGN** forms where needed
6. **BRING** all three forms to camp. DO NOT MAIL.

Also **COPY** and bring:

- The camper's immunization record
- The camper's insurance card

Remember to bring your prescription medications.

Please only send enough medication for the duration of camp.
Do not send any over-the-counter meds unless they are taken daily.
